Homeschooling is Booming in Texas and Nationally



Remember 2020, when COVID-19 resulted in a surge of families interested in homeschooling?

The numbers are surging again.

As the 2021 school year kicks off, data from THSC, HEART of Texas, and other sources indicate that many families are expressing a renewed interest in educating their children at home, spurred in particular by concern over the resurgence of COVID-19.

HEART of Texas experienced a substantial increase in the number of email and phone inquiries received from families searching for information about homeschooling.

THSC recently reported a doubling of its call and email volume in the last week of July as families clamored to prepare for school. THSC's call and email volume rose again the following week to an all-time high of 1232, exceeding their numbers from fall 2020 when COVID-19 school restrictions dominated the news and the US Census Bureau data showed the number of Texas homeschool families nearly tripling from 4.5 to 12.3% by October 2020.

Families expressed a variety of reasons for looking into homeschooling. Anne Gebhart, Executive Director for HEART of Texas stated, "When COVID-19 made virtual classrooms the norm, families found themselves homeschooling by circumstance, like it or not. The feedback we received from families indicated that some were frustrated with online curriculum, and children with special needs were at a greater disadvantage. Some families expressed concern about what their children were learning. Several families, particularly those with full-time jobs, wanted a more flexible schedule than the public school online environment would permit. Others were looking into homeschooling as a temporary option until the schools reopened."

Recent data from Time4Learning showed that 72.2% of families who began homeschooling during COVID-19 plan to continue homeschooling rather than return to public school. The <u>Associated Press</u> reported that many families felt that homeschooling was working well for them, even if they had never considered homeschooling as an option before COVID-19.

During 2020, <u>U.S. Census Bureau data</u> indicates that the largest surge in homeschooling was driven by minority families leaving the public school system. Nationwide, the rate of black families homeschooling rose from 3.3 to 16.1%. Another COVID-19 related surge in homeschooling would likely produce a similar trend.

Tim Lambert, President of THSC, stated, "In 2020 we saw the largest surge in homeschooling in history. It appears that renewed concern about COVID-19 may be about to replicate a similar trend for 2021. We are also seeing thousands of families decide to continue homeschooling because of how well it has worked for their family. Our team is here to welcome these new families into homeschooling and help them with everything they need to be successful."

In North Texas, HEART of Texas is here to serve the families in the region. "We are excited that so many families are choosing this path to educate their children at home," stated Anne Gebhart. "We continue to host Homeschool 101 programs to reach more families interested in homeschooling, and we immediately connect them with the local resources they need for a strong and successful start."
